

Instructions

- 1 Take a strip of craft paper and fold it in the middle to make an inverted right angle / an upside down L.
2. Now take the vertical strip and fold that up.
3. Turn the reverse L over to form a 7 and then fold the vertical end over again.
4. Take the horizontal end and fold it over.
5. When you look at the back you will see you have made a small square pocket.
6. Take the horizontal arm and slide it through the pocket from the back, all the way to the end and gently tug at it to ensure it is firm.
7. Slide the horizontal end to form one arm of the cross.
8. Take the other end and fold it in to form the second arm of the cross, making sure both arms are of equal length.
9. Turn the cross over and take the vertical end of the cross and gently slip it through the pocket slip from the back. Leave as much of it on top as you would like and adjust the remaining through the slit to form the foot of the cross.
